COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Christian Leadership - Provides the student with an understanding of the nature of Christian leadership and how to develop as a leader called to serve the body of Christ. Designed to help students discover how they are to live their lives in such a way that they become the Gospel in every person's world. A guided self-study into one's calling Understanding temperaments and dealing with the personalities of different Individuals. Includes discussion of what it means to be called and what is Jesus' model of leadership as well as other Biblical and modern models of leadership. Understanding temperaments in a persons life.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

1. To understand the nature of Personality temperaments in the light of Counseling and Church Administration
2. To be able to implement personality Profiles in administration and all forms of Counseling
3. To have a clear understanding of all terminology which will be discussed?
4. Identify key biblical concepts of relationship, especially as they apply to ministry and leadership.
5. Explain the essential concepts of emotional intelligence and their application to leadership.
6. Identify the levels of relationships, the qualities needed for achieving them, and the hindrances to deeper relationships.
7. Identify and apply the principles of personal growth needed to form healthy relationships.
8. Describe how temperament theory can enhance relationships.
9. Describe the ways in which relationships enhance leadership, and key
10. Relationships that determine effectiveness in ministry.
11. Implement appropriate action in dealing with relational challenges in ministry.
