COURSE SYLLABUS

I. COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will take an in depth view of the “ministry of helps”. We will examine the function of the helps ministry within the local church, the importance of its flow within an apostolic team, and the importance of building the proper relationship with the five fold ministry. This course is designed to help each student increase the anointing upon their life for areas of service. This class will enable each student to understand that to a person called to the “helps ministry” is just as much of a call of God as someone who is called to the five-fold ministry.

II. OBJECTIVES

The objective of this class is to see each student examine the role of the helps ministry and how it applies to the Body of Christ, the local church and to them individually. To see each student develop the proper motivation for helps ministry and allow each individual to be an advocate to recruit other believers to find their function in the body of Christ as it relates to Christian service.

1. Understanding the qualifications of service and staying qualified.
2. Developing excellence in the “helps ministry” (flowing in the supernatural).
3. The significance of supportive ministries (The “they” of the book of Acts).
4. Ministerial practicalities with the importance of structure.
5. Be able to develop practical guidelines with function and purpose for different helps ministry.

IV. COURSE REQUIREMENTS

1. Read “God’s Armor Bearer” before the first class begins. Complete a book report outline for required reading by Jan. 23rd (outline is on the following page). 10% of Grade
2. Mid-Term 25% of Grade
3. Final Exam of June 10th session: 35% of Grade
4. Prepare a term paper outlining the ministry of helps function that you are presently serving in. Explain what you can personally do to cause it to flourish as supernatural ministry. Give a detailed description how you can create a ministry of excellence in this ministry’s present stage due February 23rd. (outline is on following page) 30% of Grade

Book Report Outline:

1. You must submit a paper typed in 12 point font size double spaced with .5 inch borders all around. Your name, class title and page number will appear at the upper right hand corner of top page.
2. Completely answer the five following questions
 - I. Did you read the entire book?
 - II. Would the Holy Spirit agree with your answer to number 1?
 - III. Give a summary of the message of the book, not a summary of the book but of the message of the book.
 - IV. How does this message apply to your life?
 - V. Would you recommend this book to others?

Term Paper Guidelines

- I. You must submit a four page (minimum) paper typed in 12 point font size, double spaced with .5 inch borders all around. Your name, title and page number will appear at the upper right hand corner of top page.
- II. Your complete term paper must be turned in by February 23, 2010 to your class proctor. They will then mail them no later than February 25, 2010 to the following address: Rev Leon J. Schaub 4107 Vesper Circle, Palmyra, NJ 08065. Any late papers not finished by February 23, 2010 may be mailed directly to me but late papers will be reduced one letter grade per week for being late.
- III. Prepare a term paper outlining the ministry of helps function that you are presently serving in. Explain what you can personally do to cause it to flourish as supernatural ministry. Give a detailed description how you can create a ministry of excellence in this ministry's present stage
- V. You may use other textbooks for reference along with class notes and Bibles but all references must be noted.
- VI. Correct spelling, grammar and clarity of thought will be major considerations in grading your efforts.
- VI. A basic three-point approach would be a good pattern to follow in your presentation. The concept being a three part thesis that:
 - A. Introduces your topic.
 - B. Presents your main body of thought in a logical manner.
 - C. Provides a summary and conclusion emphasizing the central theme and make a clear convincing point.
